During English lessons this week, we have been working hard to improve the quality of our sentences when writing. We would like you to revise using varied sentence starters (ISPACED) so that your work in school next week is top quality!

- 1. Think of a simple sentence. E.g. The dog barked.
- Then use ISPACED to improve and expand the sentence. e.g.
- I <u>Running</u> wildly through the park, the dog barked loudly.
- S <u>As loud as an alarm</u>, the dog barked angrily at the postman.
- P <u>Beneath</u> the giant wasps' nest, the dog barked ferociously.
- A Noisily, the dog barked at the passing car.
- C <u>Suddenly</u>, the dog barked at the television screen because he saw a cat.
- E <u>Excited</u>, the dog barked all the way through the football match.
- D Even though the dog had a sore throat, he barked at the annoying children.

Write out seven sentences, as shown in the example above, but using your own simple sentence. Remember - write one sentence demonstrating each part of ISPACED. Use your ISPACED poster to help you.
