In literacy over the past week year 3 have started to write their own information leaflets. We will be continuing with this next week. The leaflets are about being a survival hero or/and The Gordon Brown Centre.

For this week's homelearning we would like the children to design a header for their leaflet. They need to be colourful and need to catch the eye of people passing by (the best ones will be put on display).

Here are some questions that they might want to think about:

- What will their title be? (e.g. Survival Heroes, the Gordon Brown Experience.....)
- Will there be any other words or questions under the header? (Catchy phrases, alliteration, persuasive phrases..)
- Will there be any pictures by the header? (photographs, pictures....)

How will they design and decorate it? What colours? What type of writing/font?

We will cut their finished product off the sheet and stick it onto their leaflet. So please don't attach it to the homework book – just tuck it in!
