Home Learning

There are 32 teams in the world cup. We have 30 children in each class plus a teacher and a teaching assistant. We have therefore got a country each, drawn from a "hat".

Your child's country is.....

Using the map provided please do the following (do use different colours, although colouring in is not essential!):

- Locate and name the northern and southern hemispheres
- Label up the north and south poles
- Label up the 7 continents
- Label up the 5 oceans
- Find and label the British Isles and label the 4 countries that make up our islands.
- Find your country and label it
- · Label the capital city of your country & try to find out the airport code for your capital city
- Label the two other countries that neighbour your country. If it is an island, you can choose 2 other countries close by.

Now, on the back of the map, explore and track down the answers to these (see back of the map):

- How far is it travel from London to your countries capital city?
- What time is it in your country if it is 3pm in London?
- What methods of transport would you most likely use to get there?
- Find out what the weather is like in your country in each of the 4 seasons
- What is your country famous for (if anything & if you know already)?
- Is there anyone famous who has come from your country?
- Draw a table and see if you can write down 5 similarities and 5 differences between your country and England.

If you have discovered anything else about your country and want to share it, feel free.

If this is a chore of a task (we know some are) and you would like your child to have some help in school to do this please let us know sooner rather than later so we can make some provision for them by sending a note to your child's class teacher.
