## Pupil Internet Agreement – 2022-2023 (Years 3 and 4)

- ☒ At St Mary's, we expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet, just as they are anywhere else in school. This includes materials they choose to access, and language they use.
- ☒ Pupils using the Internet are expected not to deliberately seek out offensive materials. Should any pupils encounter any such material accidentally, they are expected to report it immediately to a teacher.
- ☒ Pupils are expected not to use any inappropriate language in their communications and contact only people they know or those the teacher has approved.
- ☒ Pupils must ask permission before accessing the Internet and only do so with an adult present.
- ☒ Pupils should not share personal details such as usernames, passwords, addresses and phone numbers with people that are not trusted.
- ☒ No program files may be downloaded to the computer from the Internet.
- ☒ No programs on memory sticks, USB attachments or CD Rom's should be brought in from home for use in school.
- ☒ Pupils should be aware that the internet stores anything that is posted, searched and written, noting that this includes social media and games online.
- ☒ Pupils should only use computers for schoolwork and homework unless permission has been granted otherwise.
